Fees are on a sliding scale.

Accommodations:

Located 65 miles from New York City in scenic north-western New Jersey, Camp Sussex spreads out over 120 acres and fronts on a natural spring-fed lake. The grounds are constantly and carefully maintained. Every modern cabin accommodates up to 10 campers and three staff members.

Facilities:

The professionally run kitchen is a source of great pride for the camp. Hearty, nutritious, kosher-style meals are served, all prepared with care. An on-site, fully-equipped infirmary with qualified personnel provides campers with complete medical care. Laundry facilities are on the premises as well, and much of the clothing, including blankets and liners, is provided at no charge.

- Laundry facilities on premises
- Professionally run kitchen
- Three family style meals and two snacks served daily
- Fully-equipped infirmary with registered nurse
